Update from the President.....

Leave your imagination at home.....

This past winter there was much construction on the interior of the first floor of the District #1 Schoolhouse. Having completed the exterior bell tower project last year, the Lead Region Historic Trust crew with Dana Duppler as the lead, started on the interior and now you don't need to use your imagination to see the school room as it once was. Walk in the front door to the coat room and see the spiral stairway to the second floor and the two doors to the large classroom. The school room has the original wood floor, high wood ceiling, of which much is original, and wainscoted walls. You may be somewhat surprised at the color, however, research found that this may also be original. Come and see.

During the construction, a structural support beam was added to the ceiling on the first floor so there are other options for uses for the second floor. We are getting so much closer to having it finished and to be able to use the interior for community events, programs, exhibits, workshops, and meeting space. A particularly exciting use will be to give Mount Horeb students the opportunity to be taught, in period style, in the District #1 School and to experience what a school day was like in 1889.

Thanks to everyone who has helped out to this point. It is encouraging to see the progress with each new yearly project and we are closer to the attainable goal of restoration. This building serves as a clear demonstration that the built heritage of the village can and should be respected and maintained.
